

**Regulations for Admission to the Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. (Honours & General)
Courses of Studies effective from the Academic Session 2015-2016.**

Details schedule of Online application form will be declared after publication of Higher Secondary Result, 2015.

Admission Qualifications:

1. A female candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination, is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the 3-year B.A./B.Sc. (Honours./General.) Course of studies provided she has also **passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.**

However, no candidate, in general, shall be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular Course of Study after passing the previous qualifying examination. Those desirous to do so may seek permission from the University Authority.

The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the Honours Course, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks of **top four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate + Marks in subject which she intends to take as Honours/related subject.**

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the General Course, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks of **top four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate.**

However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

2. (a) A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:

(i) A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

or

ii) 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

2. (b) However, candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Community taking up Honours Course of study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate and 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

3.(a) Students, who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards/Councils or State Boards/Councils including Open Schools and vocational studies, are eligible for study at the UG level.

But, students, who have passed from the unrecognized boards, which are listed as "**Fake Educational Boards**" by the West Bengal State University are not eligible for admission.

3.(b) No migration certificate will be needed for Registration under this West Bengal State University.

3.(c) Any dispute regarding eligibility criteria would be resolved by the Equivalence Committee set up by the University.

4.For the B.A./B.Sc. (Honours/General) Course of Studies a candidate is required to choose her Honours and two/three elective subjects, as the case may be, from among Group-I to Group- VIII as follows by taking not more than one subject from any of the groups mentioned hereunder:

GROUPS

Gr. I.: Physics, Zoology, Education.

Gr. II : History, Mathematics.

Gr. III : Chemistry, Sanskrit.

Gr.IV : Botany, Economics

Gr. V : Political Science

Gr. VI : Geography, Philosophy, Journalism & Mass Communication

Gr. VII :Physiology, English

Gr. VIII :Bengali, Hindi, Urdu

5.A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject (s) under heading “**A**” if she had passed the subject (s) under heading “**B**” at the previous qualifying examination.

6. Some Special conditions for admission to Honours Courses as follows:

i) **Mathematics:** a candidate, who has passed Mathematics (and not Business Mathematics) at H.S. level, is eligible for admission to Mathematics Honours course.

ii) **Education:** Subjects Psychology, Philosophy, Mathematics, Sociology, Education, Economics, Political Science, History be treated as related subject.

iii) **Philosophy:** Subject Psychology is a related subject

7. Divisions of Honours and General subjects B.A./B.Sc.:

i) **Humanities:**

History, English, Bengali, Hindi, Urdu, Political Science, Sanskrit, Philosophy, Education, Journalism & Mass Communication.

ii) **Science:**

Physics, Zoology, Chemistry, Botany, Mathematics, Geography, Physiology, Economics.

8. A candidate taking up Honours in B.A. Degree Course shall study:

- i) Honours in any one subject of the Humanities Group and any two other elective subjects taking at least one from Humanities Group.
- ii) However, that other things remaining the same, a candidate may take up Honours course in the B.A. in the following subjects without taking any elective subject from the Group of Science:
 - a) Mathematics, b) Geography, c) Economics.

9. A candidate taking up General Course of study for the B.A. Degree shall study:

- i) Any three subjects from the Group of Humanities
- Or
- ii) Any two subjects from the Humanities Group and any one from the Science Group.

10. A candidate taking up Honours Course for B. Sc. Degree shall study:

Honours in any one subject from the Group of Science and any two other elective subjects taking at least one from the Science Group.

11. A candidate taking up General course for the B. Sc. Degree shall study:

- i) Any three subjects from the Science Group.
- ii) Any two subjects from the Science Group and any one subject from the Humanities Group.

12. Re-admission:

In continuation of discontinuation of Studies, the candidate concerned can be permitted only fresh admission and new Registration (in cancellation of the earlier registration). All such cases of fresh admission has to precede with the cancellation of earlier registration. No re-admission is admissible under the provisions of this regulation in consonance with the Act and Statute of the University.

Guide Line for Online Admission 2015-2016:

- Candidates have to apply online (mandatory) for admission in 2015-16 academic session.
- The admission will be conducted by Rishi Bankim Chandra College for Women according to the instructions and guideline given by The West Bengal State University, Barasat.
- The Online admission page will open when the candidate will click on **Online Admission-2015** link in the college website: www.rbccwomen.org or enter web site address : www.onlinerbccwomen.org.
- The rules of admission can be known by clicking on the option : **Application Procedure**.
- The Online application form will open when the candidate will click on “**Apply Online**” and choose Apply in Honours or Apply in General option.
- **The application form must be filled up properly. Boxes with stars (*) are compulsory. Moreover , necessary information can't be left incomplete.**
- It must be checked whether form has been filled correctly or not. The size of the passport photograph for online admission form must not exceed 100 kb.
- **A Candidate can not apply not more than three honours subject.**
- After carefully filled-up the online application form press **Submit Application** below the page. Confirm your application form will appear and check the form , if any modification required then press **Back** option or otherwise press Please confirm your details then submit your application form. Form Submitted Successfully message will appear on the page and an ID will be generated. Click Print Form for print the application form for admission.
- For submission of the form, the candidate must click on the option “**submit**”. An “**ID**” will appear above the photo.
- If any error is there, by chance, the candidate should click on “**Form correction**” option in the home page of “**Online Admission**”. Then she can edit/ rectify the form submitted earlier. The candidate must take a print of the filled-up form as well.
- Next, the link for Axis bank will be found in the option “**make payment**”. The candidate can pay online through net banking or debit/ credit card. The fees can be submitted offline also through cash payment in the counter. **The amount is Rs. 130/-.**
- For Net banking the candidate must fill-up the payment form. After completion of the payment procedure, an online receipt will appear which can be printed as well. An ID will be generated thereafter.
- If the candidate prefers to pay offline. She must click on the “offline payment” option and print a bank challan. Then she has to submit Rs. 130/- in any nearby branch of Axis bank after filling the bank challan. The applicant needs to retain the payment receipt copy of the bank challan.
- Once the payment is done, the candidate can't edit the admission form any more.
- After submission of fees the candidate can see her payment status (paid/ unpaid) by clicking on the “payment status” option in the home page of “Online Admission”. In case of offline payment , it can take a couple of days.
- The date for publication of merit list will be published on the due date.
- After publication of the merit list , the date of admission and other necessary information will be duly informed.

SPECIAL RULES & INSTRUCTIONS :

- i) Admission Qualification will be guided by the rules & regulations of West Bengal State University, Barasat, North 24 Parganas.
- ii) All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of West Bengal State University, Barasat, North 24 Parganas and the College authority reserves the right to cancel any admission at any time, if it finds any wrong or irregularities.
- iii) Geography and Economics in the same group be treated as B.Sc. course.
- iv) Students are asked to choose the subjects combination mentioned in the web site properly before taking admission into the College.
- v) Applicants are advised not to change their combination of subjects after admission to avoid complexity in the registration process.

- 5) Print copy of the online payment or Original received of offline Bank Challan.
- 6) For SC / ST/OBC candidates original and attested Photocopy of SC / ST/ OBC certificate issued by competent authority.
- 7) Original School Leaving certificate issued by the school from where the candidate has Passed the 10+2 Examination.
- 8) Certificates of proficiency (attested Photocopies) in Sports / Games / Co-Curricular Activities (If any)
- 9) For Challenged Category candidates, original and attested Photocopy of the relevant certificate issued by competent authority.
- 10) For BPL Card holder candidates, original and attested Photocopy of the relevant ration card issued by competent authority.
