Analysis Report of the Student's Feedback (2021-2022)

An almost 100% survey was conducted with a questionnaire to analyze the student's satisfaction in the 2020-2021 session in the pandemic situation. We categorize 3 heads under which the student's satisfaction survey was done. These are **Academic infrastructure**, **Student's support system and Teaching learning and evaluation.** In the present academic session a total of **3482** students filled the feedback in online mode. Out of these total students **575** are from B.Sc. (both Honours and General) and rest **2907** are from B.A (Honours and General).

Students are categorized broadly in two groups: Lab based students including Chemistry, Physics, Zoology, Botany, Physiology, Food and Nutrition, Journalism and Mass Communication, Geography and education as one of their main subject and non lab based students including Bengali, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Urdu, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Mathematics as one of their prime subject.
